



If you did not provide proof of insurance to the law enforcement officer at the time of your offense, you must enclose proof of insurance with your payment. Failure to provide proof of insurance may result in the suspension of your driving rights for a period of not less than 90 days.

Failure to pay or appear on your court date may result in a warrant for your arrest, additional costs and cancellation of your driver's license.

A NIGHT DEPOSIT BOX for payments is located on the east side of the Village Hall.

### **Rule 08-5.0 Court Costs**

The court costs in Cridersville Mayor's Court for traffic cases shall be \$50.00. This sum shall be distributed as follows:

- \$6.00 General fund of the Village of Cridersville
- \$10.00 Court's computerization fund, pursuant of ORC 1902.261B
- \$15.00 Treasurer of the State of Ohio for deposit in the state general revenue fund as required by ORC 2949.091
- \$9.00 Treasurer of the State of Ohio for deposit in the state preparations account pursuant to ORC 2743.70
- \$1.50 Treasurer of the State of Ohio for deposit in the state preparations account for indigent alcohol driver's treatment fund pursuant to HB562
- \$5.00 Treasurer of the State of Ohio for deposit in the state preparations account for indigent defense support fund pursuant to HB 562
- \$3.50 Treasurer of State of Ohio for deposit in the OCJS (Ohio Criminal Justice Services) indigent alcohol treatment fund pursuant to HB 562

In addition to the basic court costs above, the following additional costs shall be assessed and are payable to the village's general fund for each of the following unless ordered waived by the mayor or magistrate:

- \$5.00 Notices (Forfeiture Letters, Failure to Appear Letters, Certified Mail)
- \$20.00 License Forfeiture
- \$10.00 Service Fee
- \$6.00 Subpoenas
- \$25.00 Dishonored Checks
- \$30.00 Processing Transfers/Appeals
- \$50.00 Warrants
