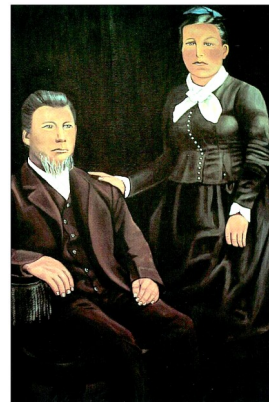


150⁺¹ YEARS

Village of Cridersville 1870 — 2021

The Covid-19 Pandemic in 2020 prevented the 150th year observance of Cridersville's incorporation - hence our 150th+1 Celebration in 2021.

- In 1854 Ephraim Crider & his son Isaac purchased 80 acres each that would become the Village of Cridersville.
- In 1856 the property was surveyed with 24 lots and in 1858 the railroad was completed running through the town.
- In 1870 Cridersville became a village under Ohio law with its incorporation.
- The village had a population of nearly 200 residents.
- 151 years later the Village of Cridersville has just over 1,800 residents.

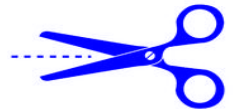
